What You'll Be Doing:

Client-Focused Support

- Coordinate our Client Services team, including dedicated volunteers and co-op students.
- **Assist** with all aspects of Client Services, from new client intake processes to providing ongoing support as clients access various services.
- **Execute** essential client processes, such as assessment, counseling, monitoring, referrals, case conferencing, and follow-up for clients.

Community Outreach & Collaboration

- **Meet regularly** with on-site community agencies to foster strong communication, problem-solving, and collaborative efforts.
- Identify and develop robust off-site community resource connections, ensuring clear referral procedures.
- Act as the primary contact / attendee for relevant community working groups.

Administration & Coordination

- **Participate** in monthly Client Service meetings to discuss new initiatives, industry standards, professional development, and team feedback, promoting communication and problem-solving.
- **Follow** our service plan program for client care and goal tracking.
- Coordinate specialty programs, including eligibility, purchasing, and distribution of supplies.
- **Oversee** enrollment for subsidized summer camp registrations, back-to-school registrations and proactively seek new subsidy opportunities to expand our reach.
- Maintain accurate data and statistical retention.
- **Procure** applicable training for the team.
- Keep a fluid document of community resources and referrals up-to-date.

What We're Looking For:

• An education **in the Social Service Field or equivalent**, two or more years of direct social work experience would be an asset, ideally working with low-income or at-risk communities.

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- The ability to establish and maintain positive working relationships with management, staff, volunteers, clients, and community agencies.
- Strong problem-solving skills, with experience in de-escalation techniques being a significant asset.
- A solid **awareness of factors leading to poverty and homelessness**, and an open, non-judgmental attitude towards individuals facing low income, mental illness, addiction, and/or disabilities.
- The **ability to work independently**, take initiative, and assume responsibility with minimal supervision.
- An enthusiastic, creative, and positive mindset.
- Supervisory experience is considered an asset.
- Strong computer literacy is considered an asset.
- Experience in the not-for-profit sector is considered an asset.

Important Details:

- This is a full-time position entry level position with a work week consisting of 35 hours.
- The salary range for this position is \$40,000 \$46,000 per annum
- Most hours will be Monday through Friday, with some evening and weekend work required. Your time will be spent on-site, working directly with clients.
- A Level 3 Vulnerable Sector Police Check is required prior to commencing work.
- A Standard First Aid certificate is required.
